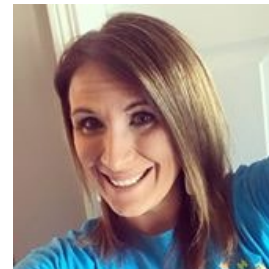

Reading Camp Specifics:

- Small group instruction, with individual sessions also available
- Focus on individual student needs not necessarily found in larger groups or classrooms
- Explicit, structured, sequential, direct approach to literacy
- Help in sorting, recognizing, and organizing the raw materials of language
- Multisensory learning capitalizing on all of the senses (not just sight and hearing) to learn how to read
- Written summary of progress and recommendations provided at the end of the program

Camp Cost:

- \$280 for the two-week program
- Payable by credit card the first day of camp
