	<p>Chatty Cats Language/Social Group Ages: 4-5</p>	<p>Mondays 11:15-11:45</p>	<p>Lindsey Wilson</p>	<p>This group targets children ages 4-5 with speech, language or other developmental delays. Each week has a new theme, with a game, book and other activities to improve social skills, understanding language, and increasing expressive communication skills.</p>
	<p>Friendly Foxes Language/Social Group Age: 5-year-olds going to kdgn</p>	<p>Tuesdays 9:30-10:00</p>	<p>Lindsey Wilson</p>	<p>This group is for 5-year-old children with speech, language, or other developmental delays. In this social skills group, children learn the importance of responding to others, appropriately taking turns when playing and talking, understanding others' actions and words, and a plethora of other necessary life skills.</p>
	<p>Speaking of Friends Elementary Social Group Grades: 2nd to 4th grade</p>	<p>Mondays 11:00-11:45</p>	<p>Maggie Wieting</p>	<p>This group helps mid-elementary age kids initiate & maintain friendships, take conversational turns, develop awareness of expected social behaviors, self-monitor & self-regulate social behavior, and improve social and behavioral flexibility.</p>
	<p>Socially Speaking Middle School Social Group Ages: 11-15</p>	<p>Tuesdays 4:30-5:15</p>	<p>Jennifer Tausch</p>	<p>This group offers peer-based interactions, common social experiences, social media scenarios, and perspective-taking opportunities for middle-school students who struggle with social situations. Structured exercises incorporate and address specific social communication goals.</p>
	<p>Social Group Upper Middle/High School</p>	<p>Wednesdays 12:00-12:45</p>	<p>Kylie Lureen</p>	<p>This program helps upper middle/high school kids develop perspective-taking, non-verbal communication, social media use, conversational turn-taking, problem-solving, self-regulation, identification of emotions, initiation & maintenance of friendships, awareness of expected vs unexpected social behaviors, and more.</p>
	<p>Reading Camp Intermediate Literacy Group Grades: Incoming 4th-6th graders</p>	<p>Mon & Wed 4:00-4:45</p>	<p>Chelsea Joekel</p>	<p>This group increases recognition and understanding of multi-syllabic words by teaching the meanings of prefixes, suffixes, and by analyzing word parts. Participants naturally make gains in reading comprehension and vocabulary knowledge. Home practice opportunities are provided after each session.</p>
